

# Financial Information

## Section I

### **Tuition and Charges – Traditional Time Programs**

The annual tuition charge for all full-time students for the year 2005-2006 is \$19,840 for 12 to 18 credits per semester. There will be an additional charge of \$395/credit for every credit over 18.

The annual room and board charge for a student residing on campus in a traditional Residence Hall for the year 2005-2006 is \$7,900. The annual room and board charge for a student residing in Bennett-Smith Hall for the year 2005/2006 is \$8,600. On a very limited basis, single rooms may become available to students at an additional charges of \$250.00 per semester. Currently there are no double/single rooms available. If there were the additional cost would be \$500.00 per semester.

A student electing to bring his/her horse to the Centenary College Equestrian Center, for the Equine Studies Program, is charged monthly for the boarding period in 2005-2006. Students should contact the Equine Center's Barn Manager for details as to costs and services available, and to make arrangements for the horse's arrival.

Tuition for part-time students is \$395 per credit hour. (See payment options in Section III) All part-time students will be assessed a \$10 student fee, payable each Fall and Spring semester with tuition, to offset special programming and services which are made available to part-time students.

Tuition for graduate program students is \$575 per credit hour. (See payment options in Section IV)

MasterCard and VISA are accepted.

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Returning Students: Fall 2006 Deposit - Due April 3, 2006	\$ 300.00	\$ 150.00
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Payment of the fall deposit entitles returning resident students to participate in the room drawing. The deposit also entitles all returning students to register for the Fall 2006 Semester. For returning students, the deposit is refundable up to **June 15, 2006**. The deposit will be deducted from the Fall 2006 tuition and fees. Newly accepted students are required to pay the deposit within 30 days of their acceptance. The deposit is refundable up to May 1, 2006.

An annual \$250 Room Damage/Key Deposit is charged to each student residing on campus. The deposit will be refunded at the end of the academic year or when a student ceases to reside on campus, less any deductions. A statement, indicating any deductions, will be mailed at that time.

The Health Service Fee is a mandatory fee, it is not optional. The fee is 100% refundable for cancellation prior to the start of the semester or withdrawal before the end of the third week of the first semester. After the third week of the first semester there is a 0% refund.

#### **Full Time Monthly Payment Plans**

Centenary is affiliated with Tuition Management Services (TMS). This company offers an Interest-Free Monthly Payment Option. Details about this monthly payment options may be obtained by contacting the Centenary Student Accounts Office or by logging on to the TMS website: [www.afford.com](http://www.afford.com). Tuition Management Services charges an annual enrollment fee of \$55.

There is a late payment fee of \$50 for all annual charge payments received after their due date. If payment arrangements are not made with the Business Office by the first day of classes, the student will not be permitted to attend classes.

Note: The payment schedule above does not include any of the required, recommended or special deposits and fees, nor does it include the additional fees for a single room, residence in Bennett-Smith Dorm, or any fines a student may incur. (See Section V of this addendum.) There are additional cost to be considered when calculating the expense of attending college but are not billed by Centenary College: books, transportation, equipment, supplies, personal expenses, child care, etc.

### **Section III**

#### **Tuition and Payment Schedule for Traditional Part-Time Studies**

All degree programs and related courses are available to part-time students, although some degree programs and/or courses may only be offered during the day sessions. A part-time student is defined as one who is taking fewer than 12 credits per semester and is a commuter. **Tuition and other charges are subject to change.**

**Tuition and fees must be paid at or before registration unless alternate plans have been approved by the Business Office. Failure to clear your bill with the Business Office may result in automatic withdrawal from courses.**

Students who are unable to pay their full tuition at the time of registration can elect to make their payments in two installments. A \$15 installment fee will be charged for using this service. ( See the “Registration Form” for details.) If the second installment payment is not received within 10 days of the due date listed on the registration form, a late payment fee of \$15 will be added. An additional late payment fee of \$10 will be added every 30 days until paid. (Maximum late payment fee of \$45.) Centenary College welcomes direct payment employee tuition assistance plans.

Students who are unable to pay their full tuition at the time of registration can elect to make their payments by Plan A or B: Plan A - The first installment of ½ the cost is due at registration. A \$15 installment fee will be charged for using this service. The second installment is due midway through the semester. Plan B – A \$200 deposit is paid at registration. A \$15 installment fee will be charged for this service. The balance is due 30 days after the start of the session or term. Late fees for both plans will be added every 30 days until paid. (Maximum late payment fee: \$45) Centenary College welcomes direct payment employee tuition assistance plans.
