

Men's Basketball (for the week ending January 31, 2010)

Division I

Player of the Week

Ryan Thompson – Rider University Senior, Guard, Mt. Laurel, N.J.

Thompson averaged 28.0 points, 10.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game in a pair of wins for the Broncs. He scored a career-high 31 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to lead Rider to an 88-80 victory over Fairfield at the Arena at Harbor Yard Saturday afternoon. In the 74-71 win over Manhattan, Thompson compiled 25 points, nine rebounds and four assists.

Division II

Player of the Week

Darnell Campbell – Lake Erie College Senior, Forward, Cleveland, Ohio

Campbell averaged 17 points and 8.5 rebounds in two games last week as Lake Erie posted a 1-1 mark. On Monday night, he recorded his third double-double in four games, and tenth of his career, with a team-leading 18 points and game-high 12 rebounds in a 79-77 loss at the buzzer on the road at Davis & Elkins. He followed that up with 16 points and five boards in a last-second 68-66 victory at home Saturday against Ohio Dominican. He also had two assists and a pair of blocks against the Panthers.

Division III – New England

Co-Players of the Week

Terrell Hollins – Brandeis University Senior, Forward, Springfield, Mass.

Hollins became the 27th 1,000-point scorer in school history as he led the Judges to a 2-0 week by averaging 16 points, 14 rebounds, 4.5 assists, 1.5 steals and 1.5 blocked shots per game, shooting 68.4 percent from the floor (13-19). He had 13 points (4-5 FG, 5-7 FT), 12 rebounds and three assists in a 70-52 win over Case, including 12 points in the second half, eight of which came in the final nine minutes. Against Carnegie Mellon on Jan. 31, Hollins had 19 points, including the 1,000th of his career, while tying a career-best with 16 rebounds. He also tallied six assists, three blocks and three steals, also game-highs.

Keith Jones – Mount Ida College
Sophomore, Guard, Boston, Mass.

Jones led the Mustangs to a perfect 3-0 week with victories over Lasell College (81-79), Emmanuel College (94-69), and Norwich University (91-89 OT). Jones averaged 29 points, five rebounds, and 3.3 assists on the week. He netted over 20 points in every game played last week, including a season high 37 points against the Saints.

Division III – Upstate

Player of the Week

Kevin Donohue – Union College
Freshman, Forward, Hudson Falls, N.Y.

Donohue scored 20 points in back-to-back road league victories on the weekend. He scored a career-high 20 points while making seven-of-nine shots and five-of-six from the line in a win at RPI. He then scored 20 points again, making seven-of-ten from the floor, in a victory at Vassar. For the week he shot 73.7 percent from the floor, connecting on 14-of-19 field goal attempts.

Division III – Metro

Player of the Week

Marcel Esonwune – York College
Junior, Center, Lagos, Nigeria

Esonwune helped the Cardinals to two conference victories to extend York's current winning streak to twelve games. His 16-point, 13-rebound performance on Wednesday helped York to a 84-72 victory over CCNY. At City Tech on Friday, he torched the Yellow Jackets for 30 points and 18 rebounds. For the week, Esonwune shot 74 percent from the floor (20-for-27) and made 6-of-7 free throws.

Division III – South

Player of the Week

Ryan Kearney – Centenary College
Senior, Forward, North Arlington, N.J.

Kearney averaged a double-double in a 2-0 week with 25.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, three steals, and two blocks per game for the week. He had a 27-point, 11-rebound and five-steal performance in a win against Marywood University and a 24 point, ten rebound, three block

performance against previously unbeaten Cabrini College. Kearney also provided stellar defense in that game, holding his man to just 30 percent shooting.
