Mastroianni is in his second season as head coach of the Cyclones. A 1999 graduate of The Pennsylvania State University, his overall record and record at Centenary College is 13-14 (.482). Prior to his appointment at Centenary, he served as associate head coach at Misericordia University in nearby Dallas, Pennsylvania. He is assisted by **Ed Ryan, Justin DeFeo, Brian Flexer, J.J. Cusick, and Joe Amador.**

##### Mike Moran - John Carroll University

A 1973 graduate of Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio, Moran is in his 18th season as head coach of the Blue Streaks. His overall record and record at John Carroll is 309-162 (.656). He has led John Carroll to eight Ohio Athletic Conference regular-season titles, three OAC tournament championships, and nine NCAA tournament appearances. He is assisted by **John Stavole, Frank O'Brien, and Connor Donelon.**

##### Adam Turner - Bard College

Adam Turner, a 2006 graduate of Bard, will begin his first season as head men's basketball coach and assistant athletics director at his alma mater. He has led the Royals to back-to-back Landmark Conference titles (2008, 2009) and two championships in Scranton's previous affiliation with the Freedom Conference (2003, 2006), along with four NCAA tournament appearances, including a Sweet 16 berth in 2003. He is 0-0 lifetime against Bard, Centenary and John Carroll. Joining him on the sidelines are **Mike Bartoletti** (Robert Morris '85, 9th year), **Canio Cianci** (Scranton '68, 18th year, 5th under Danzig), and **Ed Cosgrove** (Marywood '81, 5th year).

**Cyclone Update:** Centenary College opened its 2009-2010 season with a 99-78 loss to Misericordia University on Monday, November 15, at the Anderson Center in Dallas, Pennsylvania. In his first game in a Cyclone uniform, freshman guard Max Hughes came off the bench and poured in a game-high 25 points on 9 of 15 shooting from the field, including 5 of 5 from beyond the 3-point arc, and Ryan Kearney and Rob Urie added 15 and 13 points, respectively. Centenary also received 10 points and 10 rebounds from sophomore forward Larry Lenahan. The Cyclones shot less than 35 percent from the field and were guilty of 16 turnovers.

**Blue Streak Update:** John Carroll University, which is currently ranked second in the nation by D3hoops.com, opened its 2009-2010 season with a 90-83 victory over Olivet College in Olivet, Michigan, on Monday, November 15. Sophomore guard Corey Shontz connected on 9 of 13 field goal attempts, including 6 of 7 from beyond the 3-point arc, to finish with a game-high 28 points and guard Joey Meyer and forwards Maurice Haynes and Rudy Kirbus added 12 points apiece. The Blue Streaks, who jumped out to a 45-35 lead by intermission, connected on 11 of 18 3-point field goal attempts (61.1 percent) for the game.

**Royal Update:** The University of Scranton won its sixth straight season opener by downing Kean University, 73-64, Tuesday evening at the Long Center. The Royals shot over 57 percent from the field in the second half after opening up a four-point half by intermission. Junior guard Zach Ashworth led a balanced attack with 21 points, senior forward Eli Londo added 14 points, and sophomore forwards Matt Swaback and Matt FitzPatrick added career-highs 13 and 10 points, respectively. Tied 46-46 with 12 minutes remaining, Swaback scored five points during a 15-7 run that put the Royals ahead for good, 61-53.

list, respectively; all three averaged in double-figures last season...the Cyclones won five of their final eight games of the 2008-2009 season.

**John Carroll University:** The Blue Streaks are coming off a 25-5 season in 2008-2009...John Carroll had a season-long 21-game winning streak snapped with a 78-73 loss to Guilford College (N.C.) in an NCAA sectional semifinal game (Sweet 16) at home on March 13...the Blue Streaks averaged over 83 points a game last year...the Blue Streaks holds a 1-0 lead in the all-time series with Scranton, having defeated the Royals, 75-72, in the championship game of a tournament played at John Carroll on December 29, 1988.

**Bard College:** Bard College is located in Annandale-on-Hudson, New York, and is a member of the Skyline Conference...the Raptors struggled through a 1-24 season in 2009, but did end the year on a positive note, defeating Yeshiva University, 75-70, in their final game...senior guard Justin White averaged a team-leading 22.3 points per game...the Raptors return nine lettermen from last year's team.

**Scranton:** The Royals have won two Radisson Invitational titles (2003, 2005) and have advanced to the championship game in each of the last three years...Scranton will play its first four and six of its first eight games at the Long Center...junior guard Luke Hawk, who has been sidelined by a wrist injury, may see action this weekend; he started 27 of 28 games last season and averaged 11.1 points and 4.3 rebounds per game...junior guard Zach Ashworth is one assist shy of 150 for his career...Ashworth's game-high 21-point effort in Tuesday's win over Kean was the ninth time in his career that he has scored at least 20 points...Sophomore forward Matt Swaback scored a career-high 13 points in the first start of his career last Tuesday against Kean, eclipsing his previous high of three points on three different occasions last year...freshman guard Travis Farrell came off the bench and pulled down a team-leading seven rebounds in 20 minutes of action Tuesday against Kean.
