PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Keystone College's **Ellen Fallon** (Jr., Guard, Scranton, PA/Scranton) was named the Colonial States Athletic Conference player of the week for the week ending January 10, 2010. Fallon helped lead the team to a 2-1 mark during a week of non-conference play. The junior led the team 17 points in a 57-53 loss at Lehman College. She added 7 steals, 5 rebounds and 2 assists in that game. Fallon netted 12 points to go along with 6 rebounds and 4 steals in a 59-43 victory over College of St. Elizabeth. She capped off the week with a game high 25 points in an 88-66 win over St. Joseph's NY. The junior guard also compiled 10 steals, 9 rebounds and 4 steals, just missing a triple-double.

HONOR ROLL

Cedar Crest College's **Lizzy Sunderhaus** (So., Center, Hamilton, OH/Stephen T. Badin) was named to the Colonial States Athletic Conference honor roll for women's basketball for the week ending January 10, 2010. Sunderhaus tallied 18 points to lead Cedar Crest College basketball to a 76-65 victory over Bryn Mawr College in non-league action on Tuesday evening in Lees Gymnasium. Sunderhaus, who is ranked fourth in the nation in rebounds per game, also grabbed 11 boards in the win for the Falcons.

Jen Vasta (So., Guard, Boonton, NJ/Boonton) of Centenary College was named to the Colonial States Athletic Conference honor roll for women's basketball for the week ending January 10, 2010. In two games, Vasta recorded 33 points, 10 rebounds, 15 assists and nine steals while shooting .652 (15-of-23). In Centenary's 84-69 win over Eastern, she finished with her first career double-double, tallying 21 points and a career-high 10 assists. She also swiped seven steals and grabbed six rebounds in the win.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cabrini College's **Kevin Misevicius** (Sr. Forward, Allentown, PA/Emmaus) was named the Colonial States Athletic Conference player of the week for the week ending January 10, 2010. The Senior forward scored a program-record 45 points, shooting 13-25 overall and 16-for-16 from the foul line in a 93-85 conference win at Keystone College. Later in the week Misevicius scored another 27 points on 10-for-19 shooting in a 92-74 win against Lancaster Bible College. Misevicius ended the week with 71 points, 13 rebounds, 3 assists and 8 steals.

Honor Roll

Keystone College's **Kenneth Hardnett** (Soph. Forward, Plant City, FL/Plant City) was named to the Colonial States Athletic Conference honor roll for men's basketball for the week ending January 10, 2010. Hardnett helped lead the Giants to a 1-1 mark during the week. The forward let the team in scoring and rebounding with a 16-point, 9-rebound effort in a 93-85 loss to Cabrini. The sophomore then followed that game up with a team high 20 points to go along with 9 rebounds and 3 steals in a 88-57 win over St. Joseph's NY. Hardnett is shooting a .684 in free throws and averaging 18 points per game with 9 rebounds.
