Health Service's primary focus is to provide students with the most comprehensive health education, preventative medicine, diagnosis and treatment for injury and illness. You can assist us in this endeavor by completing and returning the original colored enclosed required health forms.

- Confidential Health History
- Physical Examination
- Immunization Record
- Meningococcal Form

These forms **must be completed and returned to Health Services by July 15th for the Fall Semester, by January 1<sup>st</sup> for the Spring Semester, and by May 15th for the Summer Semester.**

***A \$5 fee will be assessed if any form is returned late.*** The information you provide is private and confidential. It will be read only by the Health Services' staff and will be used as a reference whenever a consultation for illness or health appraisal takes place.

Send all forms to Health Service after making copies.

New Jersey State Law and Centenary College require that all students provide documented proof of immunity to measles, mumps, and rubella if born after December 31, 1956. This proof can be documentation of two measles vaccine dates, one mumps, and rubella vaccine date or two MMR dates given after the first birthday and at least thirty days apart or copies of blood tests (titer) that show the student to be immune; the Mantoux (tuberculin) skin test within the past year; a Tetanus-Booster administered within the past ten years and the completed signed Meningococcal Form. Beginning with the Fall 2004 Semester, all first time resident students who reside on campus are required to get the Meningococcal Vaccine. The new conjugate vaccine Menactra is preferred. This legislation was mandated by the State in 2004. **STARTING SEPTEMBER 2008, ALL STUDENTS TAKING 12 CREDITS OR MORE MUST RECEIVE THE HEPATITIS B VACCINE SERIES (no exemptions because of age)..**

The Varicella Vaccine and Gardasil Vaccine Series are strongly recommended, but not required.

Please discuss these vaccines with your primary care giver, as we will require an itemized list of all immunizations, including month, day, and year of when each vaccine was administered. If you have previously received only one immunization for measles, you must receive a second (an MMR is recommended). If a titer was done, please submit the lab results. Requests for medical and religious exemptions must be in writing and included with the Immunization Form. All vaccines are available in Health Services at cost.

**STUDENTS WHO FAIL TO SUBMIT COMPLETED HEALTH FORMS WITH ADEQUATE IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENTATION WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES, HAVE ID VALIDATED, OR RECEIVE GRADES.**

Please obtain the official proof of immunization or immunity from your high school, previous college, public health department, or health care provider. If a titer was done, the lab results must be submitted. Include your name and social security number on all documents.
