A Brief History

In the wake of Hurricane Katrina there was a national call for volunteers to help with rebuilding the Gulf Coast region. In January 2006, a group of 125 students, faculty and staff from Centenary College in Hackettstown, NJ and Drew University in Madison, NJ traveled to New Orleans and worked on houses there for 10 days. Working under the auspices of the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR), work teams were assigned to help homeowners who were either under insured or uninsured. By the time the group was ready to return to New Jersey, they had worked on 120 homes clearing away large amounts of debris.

A year later, the two schools joined up again to send down another 125 students, faculty and staff to the Greater New Orleans area to continue the work they started in 2006. The work included roofing, sheet-rocking, debris removal and the rebuilding of a barn for a horse farm. More than 16 months after Katrina there were still homes that had their contents inside and people waiting for the insurance companies on payment. In the end, over 100 homes were worked on and dozens of families could take the next step in the rebuilding process.

Last year both schools returned to the New Orleans area. This time our mission was to rebuild houses. We worked with two fantastic organizations; Habitat for Humanity and the St. Bernard Project. Teams from both schools helped build houses from scratch in the now famous Musician's Village section and other Habitat projects throughout New Orleans. St. Bernard Project is a rebuilding organization; they use volunteer labor and donations for building supplies to rebuild homes. On average, it takes them 8-12 weeks and \$12,000 worth of building supplies to completely rebuild a house that has been gutted to the studs. Our teams were assigned to homeowners for the entire week as they helped them rebuild their current home. These jobs ranged from installing flooring and doors to hanging dry wall and interior painting. The bonds formed with those homeowners and families are ones that our teams will have forever.

January 2009, both schools are committed to helping a region that has been struck by disaster. At the moment we are currently investigating the best way we can help with our hard-working force of mostly unskilled labor. It is something we are strongly committed to and we expect to be helping an area of the country that desperately needs it. The 2008 Centenary College and Drew University Disaster Relief Golf Classic will be the major fundraiser for the group. The monies raised will help defray the costs of individuals going on the trip.
